Job Opportunity – Minister of Music

St. Philip Lutheran Church is seeking a musician to foster nourishing spiritual experiences through leading congregational singing, coordinating special music, and conducting the church choir. We worship in an energetic, liturgical style utilizing *Evangelical Lutheran Worship* and enjoy a wide diversity of music. The primary instrument of the congregation is piano, but we would love to work with a dynamic musician skilled in both piano and organ.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Coordinate and lead music for Sunday morning worship (9 am) and special worship services (midweek Advent, Christmas Eve, Ash Wednesday, midweek Lenten, Holy Week, etc.).
- 2. Assist in planning worship and other musical activities of the congregation in coordination with the pastor and Worship & Music team.
- 3. Lead weekly rehearsals with choir and other ensembles ensembles as appropriate throughout the year. Groups may include, but are not limited to: adult choir, praise/contemporary band or choir, bell choir, instrumental ensembles, etc.
- 4. Recruit and nurture the gifts of musicians (vocalists and instrumentalists) of all ages.
- 5. Participate in weekly staff meeting and monthly Worship & Music committee meeting to help facilitate the goals of the congregation.
- 6. Maintain the music library and coordinate the maintenance of instruments (organ, grand piano, upright piano, and handbells).
- 7. Lead music for weddings, funerals, and special events at St. Philip as available.

Skills and qualifications:

- 1. Bachelor's degree in music, church music, or other related degree.
- 2. Demonstrated knowledge of Lutheran theology and liturgical practice.
- 3. Demonstrated skill and competency at the keyboard, particularly piano.
- 4. Experience and competency directing choirs of all age groups.
- 5. Ability to work well with others and participate collegially with staff members, Pastors, and congregational leaders.

Compensation:

This is a part-time position, with approximately 5 hours on-site plus planning and preparation. Salary range is \$13,000-\$16,000, negotiable based on education and experience, subject to annual performance review.
